Global Polymer Prices

- South Asian PP prices for raffia grade dropped \$10/mt in the past week to \$970-1000/mt as sluggish demand prevailed despite the impending Indian holiday season
- The Asian polypropylene market contracted week over week, driven mostly by lower prices in the Chinese domestic market, which decreased by Yuan 250/mt on the week to Yuan 7,600/mt.
- Prices are comparable to last week's, but owing to recent events between Israel and Palestine, it is anticipated that they may increase next week.
- This week, US spot export and contract domestic polypropylene prices remained stable week over week as feedstock costs rise and fundamentals became more difficult for PP market players.
- In the week leading, the Turkish polypropylene market saw a little increase as providers held prices steady despite increased upstream costs in October.
- When import supply decreased in the early part of the month, more customers turned to leave product courses

South Asian PP prices decline this week

South Asian PP prices for raffia grade dropped \$10/mt in the past week to \$970-1000/mt as sluggish demand prevailed despite the impending Indian holiday season. According to PLASTICUPDATES reporters from the Indian market, PP customers have built up finished goods inventories since there hasn't been much demand for downstream end products despite predictions of increased consumption during the holiday season.

Chinese PP prices decline this week

The Asian polypropylene market contracted week over week, driven mostly by lower prices in the Chinese domestic market, which decreased by Yuan 250/mt on the week to Yuan 7,600/mt. Trade volumes in China exceeded expectations, and domestic prices started to fall as soon as business restarted after the Golden Week vacation. Prices were predicted to decline since pre-holiday restocking had already increased demand.

Brazil PP prices remain stable this week

In the week leading, the Brazilian PP market saw consistent demand as market players reported low buyer appetite due to unfavourable macroeconomic conditions. Prices are comparable to last week's, but owing to recent events between Israel and Palestine, it is anticipated that they may increase next week.

Spot PP homopolymer price was estimated at \$1,150-1,180/mt, being consistent from week to week. This week, the copolymer grade was estimated at \$1,190-1,220/mt, which was constant for the week.

US PP prices remain stable this week

This week, US spot export and contract domestic polypropylene prices remained stable week over week as feedstock costs rise and fundamentals became more difficult for PP market players. Demand for the majority of PP grades is still consistently weak, with consumption quantities of flexible packaging falling dramatically. In the US, people are choosing the same product in a larger bag over the smaller or individual size packets of salty snack foods. The FAS Houston spot homopolymer injection grade polypropylene export prices were stable and were measured at \$1,050-1,080/mt during the week. The FAS Houston co-polymer grade polypropylene was stable and was measured at \$1,090-1,120/mt during the week.

Turkey polypropylene prices increase this week

In the week leading, the Turkish polypropylene market saw a little increase as providers held prices steady despite increased upstream costs in October. PLASTICUPDATES estimated the current CFR Turkey polypropylene fibre price at \$1,020-1,050/mt, up \$10/mt for the week.

European polypropylene prices increase this week

The week leading up saw little change in the European polypropylene market due to volatile market circumstances along the whole value chain. During the week, sellers successfully passed along the Eur60/mt increase in propylene contract prices to both spot and contract markets. When import supply decreased in the early part of the month, more customers turned to local product sources.

The FD NWE Homopolymer injection polypropylene spot prices were up by Eur60/mt and were measured at Eur1,150-1,180/mt during the week. The FD NWE Copolymer PP spot prices were up by Eur40/mt and were measured at Eur1,230-1,260/mt during the week.
