Global Polymer Prices

- The spot homopolymer polypropylene price was evaluated by PLASTICUPDATES and was constant during the week at \$990-1,020/mt.
- PLASTICUPDATES evaluated spot homopolymer at \$1,030-1,060/mt, up \$30/mt over the previous week, mostly due to increased costs
- PLASTICUPDATES data for October indicated that Mexico and Canada accounted for almost 66% of outflows.
- PLASTICUPDATES maintained the \$900-930/mt grade for CFR SE Asia BOPP, unchanged from the previous week.
- The FAS Houston co-polymer grade polypropylene was stable and was measured at \$1,110-1,140/mt during the week.
- The FD NWE Homopolymer injection polypropylene spot prices were down by Eur10/mt and was measured at Eur1,000-1,030/mt during the week
- CFR Turkey polypropylene fibre spot prices were evaluated at \$920-950/mt, down \$20/mt for the week.

Brazil PP prices remain stable this week

In comparison to Dec. 8, the Brazilian market witnessed consistent import prices for PP homopolymer and copolymer. The market is already beginning to slow down, and the stability is being attributed to the fact that many businesses are taking group holidays. People are lowering their prices to sell and increasing volume as a result of the sharp decline in demand. The spot homopolymer polypropylene price was evaluated by PLASTICUPDATES and was constant during the week at \$990–1,020/mt.

WCSA PP prices increase this week

Prices for both homopolymer and copolymer grades were higher on South America's west coast. It was said that products might be sent to Ecuador, Peru, Chile, and Colombia. PLASTICUPDATES evaluated spot homopolymer at \$1,030–1,060/mt, up \$30/mt over the previous week, mostly due to increased costs. Most of the rates and bids that were heard were at least \$1,050 per metric tonne.

PLASTICUPDATES: Data News (PP)

US PP outflows grew from July–October, with October's export total being the largest yet in 2023. US PP exports in October came to 183,462 mt, which was 45% more than in October 2022 and up 5% from September's shipments.

Because Asian-origin resin is still competitive in international export markets, PP exports have stayed regional. PLASTICUPDATES data for October indicated that Mexico and Canada accounted for almost 66% of outflows. 9,887 mt, or 5% of all outflows in October, were received by Belgium, the only other nation to receive at least 5% of exports.

Asian polypropylene prices increase this week

Asian polypropylene prices were steady to higher this week, countering a weakening upstream market in China with tighter production rates. Chinese PP prices were constantly strong in the week leading up to December 18, despite the upstream crude oil and propane markets continuing to perform poorly. Prices increased due to a mix of positive sentiment following the government's Politburo meeting and somewhat lower PP production rates, which were reported to be between 75 and 80 percent as producers trimmed rates because of low profits.

PLASTICUPDATSE valued CFR FE Asia's raffia/injection grade at \$850-880/mt, which remained constant during the week. CFR FE Asia IPP film grade prices were \$10/mt higher on the week at \$850-880/mt. CFR FE Asia BOPP grade prices were \$10/mt higher on the week at \$850-880/mt.

PLASTICUPDATES valued the CFR FE Asia block COPOL at \$880-910/mt, \$10/mt more than the previous week.

Raffia/injection grade PP was valued at \$880-910/mt CFR SE Asia, which was unchanged from the previous assessment.

During the week, PLASTICUPDATES evaluated film grade PP at \$900–930/mt CFR SE Asia, remaining constant. PLASTICUPDATES maintained the \$900-930/mt grade for CFR SE Asia BOPP, unchanged from the previous week.

US polypropylene prices remain stable this week

The week ending on December 16 saw little movement in the US polypropylene market as export prospects were further restricted by growing feedstock prices. No fresh indications of spot export for homopolymer or copolymer PP were received. Every week, the homopolymer and fibre domestic contract prices, as well as both grades, were evaluated in the same way.

The FAS Houston spot homopolymer injection grade polypropylene export prices were stable and were measured at \$1,070-1,100/mt during the week. The FAS Houston co-polymer grade polypropylene was stable and was measured at \$1,110-1,140/mt during the week.

European polypropylene prices decline this week

The week saw little change in the European polypropylene market due to a combination of weak demand, fundamentally weak value chain circumstances, and the rapidly approaching Christmas vacations. Throughout

the weak, consumption stayed low due to the poor demand from all downstream sectors, which decreased the requirement for materials and drove down prices throughout the market.

The FD NWE Homopolymer injection polypropylene spot prices were down by Eur10/mt and was measured at Eur1,000-1,030/mt during the week. The FD NWE Copolymer PP spot prices were down by Eur10/mt and were measured at Eur1,080-1,110/mt during the week

Turkey polypropylene prices decline this week

The week saw a fall in the Turkish polypropylene market as few buyers responded to supplier bids. CFR Turkey polypropylene fibre spot prices were evaluated at \$920-950/mt, down \$20/mt for the week. There were no deals reported as completed throughout the week, indicating a sluggish week in the market. Participants reported low demand and limited liquidity due to fewer offerings on the market.

PLASTICUPDATES: Offer News (PP Film)

A Saudi Arabian producer is rumoured to have offered its PP Film (520L/PP 526P) grades in West Africa at the \$1,190/mt levels. This offer is for shipment on a CFR Benin Main Port basisa for December 2023.

Prices for polymer-grade propylene increase in the US

Prices for polymer-grade propylene increased somewhat in the US. Prices for polymer-grade spot-delivered propylene were evaluated at 45–46 cents/lb FD US Gulf levels, up 1 cent from last week. Prices for spot-supplied propylene of refinery grade were consistently evaluated at 10–11 cents per pound FD in the US Gulf.
