Global Polymer Prices

- The price of CFR North Africa HIPS remained stable at \$1,330-1,360/mt over the week.
- The majority of recyclers were reportedly considering December 15 as their final working day before the Christmas holidays due to the dismal market demand situation.
- Due to persistently low demand, US spot export polystyrene prices were evaluated as unchanged for the week.
- The FD NWE acrylonitrile-butadiene-styrene spot prices were evaluated and were Eur1,530-1,560/mt this week, down Eur100/mt.
- The general-purpose polystyrene spot price for CFR Turkey remained stable at \$1,230-1,260/mt for the week
- East China's domestic ABS prices were reported to be approximately \$1,170/mt when considering import parity.
- At Eur1,600-1,630/mt FD NWE, the high impact polystyrene spot price remained stable throughout the week.

African Polystyrene prices remain stable this week

The demand for PS in North Africa was sluggish, and there was little trade activity. Due to lower run rates in the industry, there has been a decrease in supply, which has helped spot styrene prices rise in Europe recently. The week's CFR North Africa GPPS spot price of \$1,280-1,310/mt was determined without modification. The price of CFR North Africa HIPS remained stable at \$1,330-1,360/mt over the week.

European Recycled Polystyrene prices remain stable this week

Before talks on the contract price settlement for virgin feedstocks like benzene and styrene, the European recycled polystyrene market was reported to remain steady. Spot activity was minimal throughout the last week of November.

The majority of recyclers were reportedly considering December 15 as their final working day before the Christmas holidays due to the dismal market demand situation. It was anticipated that production would be minimal until December.

Consistent week rates for recycled polystyrene black pellets at Eur900-930/mt DDP Northwest Europe. R-PS grey pellets were valued at 1,120-1,150 euros per metric tonne of DDP NWE, with weekly fluctuations.

US spot export polystyrene prices remain stable this week

Due to persistently low demand, US spot export polystyrene prices were evaluated as unchanged for the week. Export general-purpose PS prices were estimated to be \$1,660-1,690/mt FAS. Houston, no signs of decline, unchanged for the week. Spot export high-impact PS prices at \$1,820-1,850/mt FAS, which remained steady throughout the week. The prices of domestic GPPS and HIPS were stable at 94.5 cents per pound and 104.5 cents per pound, respectively.

European ABS prices decline this week

The week ending saw pressure on European ABS spot prices as producers grappled with a combination of a decline in demand that was driven by lower local demand in Asia and a surge in cheaper imports that were readily accessible. The FD NWE acrylonitrile-butadiene-styrene spot prices were evaluated and were Eur1,530-1,560/mt this week, down Eur100/mt.

Turkey PS prices remain stable this week

The week leading to December saw a slowdown in the Turkish polystyrene market due to low trading liquidity as buyers continued to exercise caution. The general-purpose polystyrene spot price for CFR Turkey remained stable at \$1,230–1,260/mt for the week.

Asian ABS prices remain stable this week

This week, PLASTICUPDATES rated Asian acrylonitrile-butadiene-styrene as steady week over week at \$1,240-1,270/mt CFR Southeast Asia and down \$10/mt week over week at \$1,230-1,260/mt CFR China. In the Chinese market, there was a noticeable lack of demand and a large difference between buyers and sellers. Upstream markets were likewise gloomy at the moment; CFR China for critical feedstock styrene monomer fell by \$40/mt every week. East China's domestic ABS prices were reported to be approximately \$1,170/mt when considering import parity.

European polystyrene prices remain stable this week

The week saw no change in the European polystyrene market. Due to the persistently low demand, producers were forced to sell their products at a loss. Packaging materials are in less demand as producers switch to corrugated cardboard.

General purpose polystyrene spot price was evaluated at Eur1,510-1,540/mt FD NWE, remaining consistent over the previous week. At Eur1,600-1,630/mt FD NWE, the high impact polystyrene spot price remained stable throughout the week. In Eur1,680-1,710/mt FD NWE, the spot price for expandable polystyrene remained consistent throughout the week.

US ABS prices remain stable this week

PLASTICUPDATES evaluated US acrylonitrile-butadiene-styrene supplied on a rail car basis at 70.1 cents per pound, stable this week. There were no transactions, offers, or bids received. ABS injection pricing yielded inconsistent outcomes in foreign markets.

Asian PS prices sees mixed sentiment this week

The general-purpose polystyrene market in Asia was mixed this week, estimating a \$10/mt increase to \$1,160-1,190/mt based on deals heard around that level. Nonetheless, data suggesting weaker pricing led to a reduced assessment of Southeast Asia's GPPS and high-impact polystyrene prices. At \$1,160-1,190/mt CFR SE Asia, GPPS was down \$10/mt and HIPS was down \$15/mt, respectively.
